ACKLEY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION TO GET UNDERWAY IN PARMA HEIGHTS

Parma Heights - Konstruction King, Inc. is scheduled to begin reconstruction of Ackley Road between Denison and Brookmere the week of July 9th. The project, which is being funded through the cooperative efforts of the Cuyahoga County Department of Development through a Block Grant and City of Parma Heights Capital Improvement funds, is expected to take approximately five to six weeks to complete.

“We recognize the construction will cause some inconvenience to our residents and we greatly appreciate their cooperation in making this a successful reconstruction project,” said Mayor Michael P. Byrne.

“During construction, traffic will be limited to one-way local traffic with detours posted,” explained Dan Neff, Parma Heights City Engineer. “Homeowners will need to make efforts to park in neighbors’ drives while the construction proceeds in front of their home as parking on the street will be prohibited. Residents should expect to be out of their drives for up to ten days while the roadway work is being completed and the concrete meets the necessary cure time.”

The project will include full removal of the deteriorated pavement and the construction of new concrete pavement, new under drains and the rebuilding of roadside catch basins. The new work will be limited to the existing roadway and will not include replacement of any drive aprons.
