Parma Heights - "The City of Parma Heights' excellent record keeping has earned it the Auditor of State Award," according to the office of Auditor of State Dave Yost.

"The yearly audit is an important resource that tells our citizens that we are using their money well and wisely," commented Mayor Michael P. Byrne. "A clean audit is one of the best accolades our city, and our Director of Finance Terry Hickey, could receive."

The Auditor of State Award, presented to local governments and school districts upon the completion of a financial audit, is given to those entities that file timely financial reports in accordance with GAAP (Generally Accepted Accounting Principles), as well as receive a "clean" audit report that did not contain findings for recovery, material citations, material weaknesses, significant deficiencies, Single Audit findings or any questioned costs.

The Auditor of State's office, one of five independently elected statewide offices, is responsible for auditing more than 5,800 state and local government agencies.
