

PARMA HEIGHTS CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS
EXTRA CREDIT

12. Credit for Military Service. Requests for the additional credit for military service, as defined in Section 124.23 of the Revised Code, together with an honorable discharge or other proof of satisfactory Service, provided that applicant has served a minimum of 180 days with honorable discharge, shall be Submitted to the Commission with the application for examination or credit for military service will not be given. When proper proof of acceptable service in the Armed Forces of the United States, as defined in Section 124.23 of the Revised Code, is presented to the Commission and such ex-serviceman or woman being otherwise eligible has received a passing grade of seventy (70%) percent, or as otherwise specified in these Rules and Regulations, in any regular entrance examination, he or she shall be granted additional credit of ten (10%) percent of such grade.

13. Educational Credit for Entry Level Examinations. (A) Police Department (1) Any applicant for a position with the police department who has a Bachelor's Degree or 2 years actual full time experience as a municipal, state or federal law enforcement officer shall be entitled to additional credit of ten (10) percent of applicant's earned grade which will be added to the applicant's examination score, provided the applicant receives a passing earned grade in the competitive exam of seventy (70%) percent or as otherwise specified in these Rules and Regulations. **(2)** Any applicant for a position with the police department who has an Associate's Degree shall be entitled to additional credit of six (6) percent of applicant's earned grade which will be added to the applicant's examination score, provided the applicant receives a passing earned grade in the competitive exam of seventy (70%) percent or as otherwise specified in these Rules and Regulations **(3)** Upon receipt of proper proof of: Accredited college class hours, additional credit shall be added to the applicant's examination score in the percentage corresponding to the credit hours attained on the following schedules, provided that the applicant receives a passing earned grade in the competitive exam of seventy (70%) percent or as otherwise specified in these Rules and Regulations.

Credit hours, as the term is used herein, shall be construed to mean quarter hours. In the event that an applicant presents a certified transcript from a college or university using the semester hour system, the Commission shall convert said semester hours to quarter hours on the basis of five (5) quarter hours for each three (3) semester hours of credit. **(4)** Upon receipt of proper proof of: State of Ohio Peace Officer's Basic Training Academy Program accredited certificate by the State's Attorney General that is valid and current, additional credit shall be added to the applicant's examination score in the percentage of five (5) percent of applicant's earned grade in the competitive examination score, provided the applicant receives a passing earned grade of seventy (70) percent or as other wise specified in these Rules and Regulations. This credit cannot be in addition to any credit received under section **13. (A)(1)(2)**.
