

“CLEAN UP, GREEN UP” SEMINAR TO TEACH ABOUT HAZARDOUS WASTES IN THE HOME

Garfield Heights, OH – The Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District will be holding a free, interactive lecture on the proper management of household hazardous wastes on Thursday, May 10 at the Parma City Hall Council Chambers, 6611 Ridge Road at 6:30 p.m. Attendees should use the back entrance of city hall.

The seminar, "Clean Up, Green Up: Removing Home-Based Hazardous Materials," is a 90-minute program designed to help people learn about common products in their home that may be hazardous and how to properly store and dispose of them. In addition, the seminar will provide information about safer substitutes for common household cleaning products. The seminar is open to all Cuyahoga County residents.
