Thank you for the submission of the compliance report dated December 15, 2005.

Although our deed requires 10 biennial reports, *and as further determined by the Secretary of the Interior*, we feel the report submitted demonstrates that Nathan Hale Park has been fully developed in accordance with the program of utilization. Accordingly, a compliance report submitted every five years will be sufficient for our needs. We look forward to the next report which will be due December 15, 2010.

In addition, as part of the terms contained in the quitclaim deed, it is required that the City of Parma Heights erect and maintain a sign acknowledging that the property was conveyed by the National Park Service's Federal Lands to Parks Program. We look forward to receiving the photo showing that the sign has been installed no later than the end of the winter season.
