



Forged on June 1, 2011, between Parma Heights Mayor Michael Byrne and Brooklyn Mayor Richard Balbier, this community partnership allows Parma Heights residents to join the Brooklyn Recreation Center at a discounted rate for all amenities not duplicated in the City of Parma Heights.

Recreation options range from the use of an indoor pool, whirlpool, steam room, sauna, an ice-skating facility with clubs and competitions, a cardiovascular exercise room, and a variety of classes.

The “Buddy Program” is a recreation program for children with special needs. Special needs children and their families can participate in baseball, basketball, swimming and ice-skating programs adapted to their needs.

Brooklyn Recreation offers a “Silver Sneakers” fitness program for Parma Heights residents that are 65 or older. Many health plans include this membership as part of their benefit - check yours!

Two (2) proofs of residency are required to join and there is a \$5.00 identification card fee.

Children ages 9 and younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.

Children ages 5 and under will be admitted FREE when accompanied by a paying adult.

SEASON PASSES

EARLYBIRD DISCOUNT: Anyone purchasing a pool pass on Saturday, May 2nd or 9th will receive a \$5 discount for individuals and a \$10 discount for families.

Residents must bring a current utility bill and valid drivers license to receive resident rates

*A “family” is defined as 7 directly related individuals which includes a maximum of 2 adults and 5 children or 1 adult and 6 children, stepchildren or foreign exchange students under the age of 19 who reside in the same domicile. Each child after the 7th family member who is over the age of 5 must pay an additional \$20/resident or \$30/non-resident. Extended family members such as in-laws and cousins are NOT included.

Available for purchase at the pool. Resident rate only available with a one-time purchase of a \$5.00 Resident ID, valid for two (2) years.

A valid driver’s license or state ID is required for a Resident ID.

AQUATIC PROGRAMS

SWIM LESSONS RED CROSS (Levels I-VII)

Purchase of a season pool pass is required to register for swim lessons. Registration is limited to residents only (non-residents on a space available basis). Fee: \$10/session

Parents or legal guardians can register children on Saturday, May 2nd or 9th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. in the gymnasium at St. John Bosco Church; 6480 Pearl Road.

Session I: June 8th - June 25th (Monday-Thursday)

Note: Minimum age for beginners is six (6) by 6/1/15

Session II: July 6th - July 23rd (Monday-Thursday)

Note: Minimum age for beginners is six (6) by 7/1/15

AQUA ZUMBA

Participants must be 16 years or older. Information about class schedule and cost will be available at the pool.

SWIM TEAM

Fun for swimmers ages 6-18 who will be coached to learn and improve swimming skills, including the butterfly, breaststroke, backstroke and freestyle swim strokes as well as flip turns.

As a member of the Cuyahoga Valley Swim League, the season includes ten dual meets and a season championship against teams from Brecksville, Forest Hills, Independence, Parma and Greenwood Village.

Practice is available twice a day at the Parma Heights pool for swimmers with a season pool pass. The team fee is \$30.

BOCCÉ BALL SHUFFLEBOARD SAND VOLLEYBALL

Open the same days and hours as the pool, you can bring your own equipment or use the city's with a \$5.00 refundable deposit and ID.

BASEBALL/SOFTBALL

Registration will be held at Yorktown Lanes (6218 Pearl Road) on Saturday, March 7th and 14th from 9:00-11:00 a.m. The registration fee is \$30 for residents and \$50 for non-residents, which includes a uniform shirt and baseball cap. A late fee of \$10 will be assessed after March 15, 2015. Proof of residency is required at the time of registration.

The ages for the girls league this year are 7-9, 10-12, 13-15 and co-ed softball for ages 16-18. The boys league will continue to be for ages 7-8, 9-10, 11-12 and 13-15 and T-ball for ages 5-6.

TENNIS

Newly-renovated tennis courts are located in the Greenbrier Commons at 6200 Pearl Road and are open under the lights until 10:00 p.m.

Tennis lessons are available for ages 7-17. There are limited openings for the two sessions, each consisting of nine, 1-hour lessons. Registration will be held on Saturday, May 2nd and May 9th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. in the gymnasium at St. John Bosco Church; 6480 Pearl Road.

Practice begins in August and games are played Saturday mornings in September and October: 5-6 year olds play at N.E.O. Soccer and 7-9 year olds play at the Reservoir fields.

Registration is Wednesday, June 10th and 17th from 4:30-6:30 p.m. downstairs at the Cassidy Theatre. The fee is \$40 and we accept cash and check only. A current utility bill and the child's most current report card are required at the time of registration.

YOGA with PILATES

The Parma Heights branch of the Cuyahoga County Public Library system has an inspiring and unique history. Parma Heights was the first city in Ohio to pass a bond issue for the construction of a library building. In 1960, a \$160,000 bond issue made the Parma Heights branch possible and in 1997, another bond issue was passed to remodel, modernize and expand the space including the addition of computers and meeting rooms.

The library has WiFi and the use of Internet, computer and word processing equipment. There are monthly children's reading, school age and teenage programs, as well as programs for adults and book discussion groups.

FRIENDS OF THE PARMA HEIGHTS LIBRARY

Friends of the Library sponsor free entertainment and educational programs throughout the year and provide valuable support to the library through fundraising.
