MAYOR BYRNE TO HOST STORMWATER WORKSHOP

Sewer District Representative to Speak

Parma Heights – Mayor Michael P. Byrne will host an informational workshop in City Hall Council Chambers at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 5, 2013, designed to provide residents with information about the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District's (NEORS) new Regional Stormwater Management Program. The workshop will also include information on how to apply for an individual 25 percent Residential Property Credit.

"Our community and its residents care about the environment and stormwater management is a crucial element," said Byrne. "We are pleased that the NEORS Watershed Team Leader for Parma Heights, Matthew Scharver, will be here explain this important program to our residents in person, answer their questions and address their concerns."

The Sewer District's Regional Stormwater Management Program will allow the agency to address flooding, streambank erosion and water quality programs throughout its defined Stormwater Service Area. In addition, the Sewer District will assume responsibility for millions of dollars of necessary maintenance along streams across the region.

For residents unable to attend the meeting, the Sewer District is also holding monthly informational workshops at their Administrative Offices at 3900 Euclid Avenue in Cleveland, on the second Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. The next meetings are scheduled for February 13, March 13 and April 8.
